- Photos are permitted to be included in ads that are full and 1/2 page only at no additional charge.
- Photographs must be emailed to info@doriemiller915.org.
- If you are unable to email your photograph, please speak with the Dorie Miller Post#915 veteran you are sponsoring to make certain your photo is in their possession no later than October 1, 2009
- If mailing please label backs of all photos. We will return your photo to the veteran that you sponsoring.
- Ads that are prepared for our souvenir book by your organization can be emailed to info@doriemiller915.org. We prefer PDF. We will accept Microsoft Publisher, Microsoft Word, Microsoft PowerPoint, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe InDesign, Adobe Photoshop. We prefer that you arrange your full page ad to print 8.5 x 11. You may arrange your full page ad to print 11 x 8.5, however it will appear horizontal in the Souvenir Book. All half page ads must be arranged 8.5 (width) x 5.5 (length). The final dimensions will be slightly less. We have to allow for margins.
