

## Important Program Information



- 1. Veterans *in need* call the program Chairman phone number located within this brochure.
- 2. Veterans will be Pre-screened for program eligibility during their initial phone call.
- 3. During the Pre-screening process the Veteran will be asked a series of questions to determine eligibility and request proof of documentation to be sent to the program Chairman.
- 4. Each Veterans' case is unique and will be treated as such.
- 5. VS Program eligible Veterans will be informed of the VS Program approved dentist available in their area.
- 6. The program Chairman will work directly with each of the dental providers, to ensure the highest quality of dental care and services for each of the Veteran program participants.
- 7. Once all aspects of the Veterans care have been met, eligibility, dental visits, dental need determination, etc... the Veteran dental care will be scheduled.

**Disclaimer:** Each Veterans' dental needs can vary and must be evaluated on an individual basis. No two Veterans' dental issues or needs are the same. Each Veterans' dental issue will be considered as unique as the Veteran themselves.
